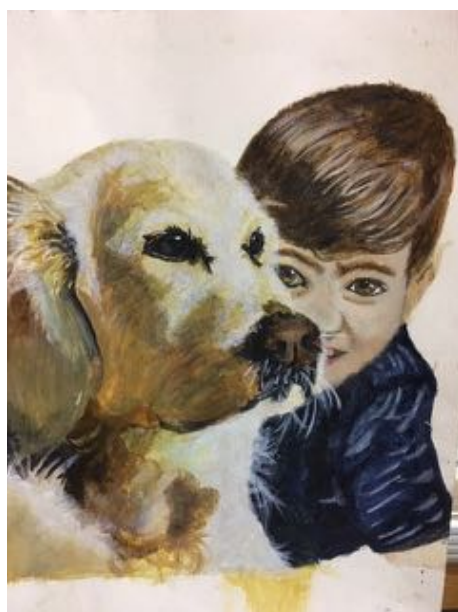


Pre-Prep Christmas Play
