Proposed Uniform Change



We have become increasingly aware through discussion with games staff and the MPPA that the children require a warm and waterproof piece of sports kit. It is proposed that we introduce a waterproof and fleece lined hooded jacket which will replace the tracksuit top and ultimately the green coats. We will phase them in over the next two years, at which point they will become compulsory and they will be in the uniform shop from the Christmas holidays. The jacket will retail at £56.
