Chapel

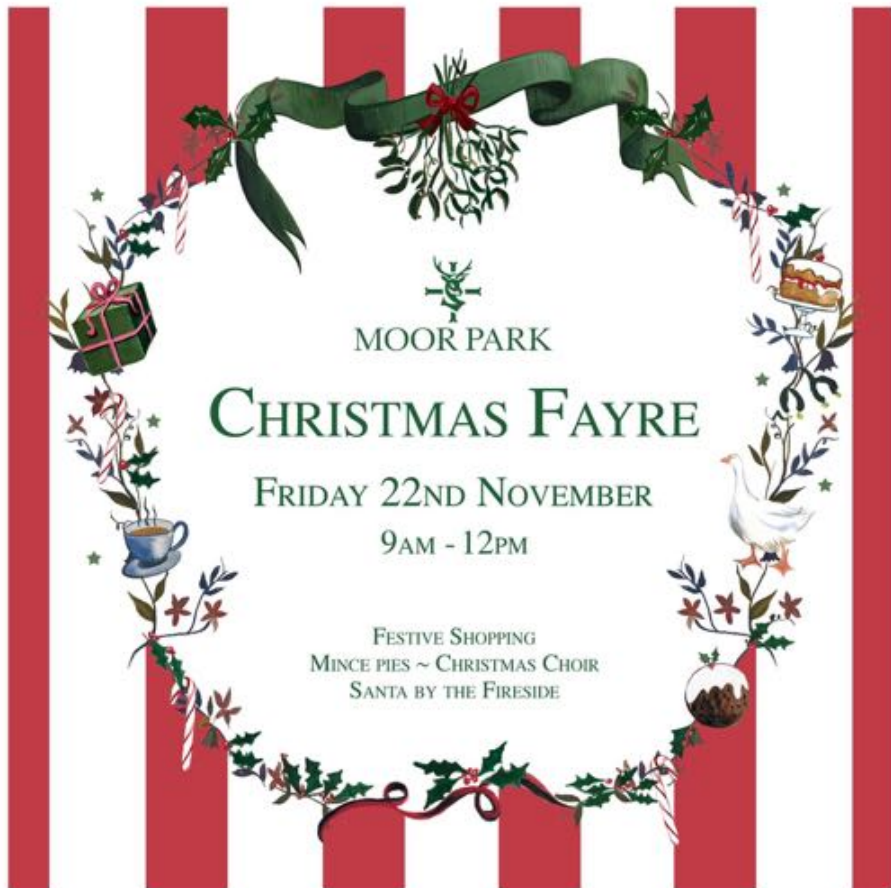
No Mass this week, but the sacristy and choir team have already begun preparations for Advent.
